

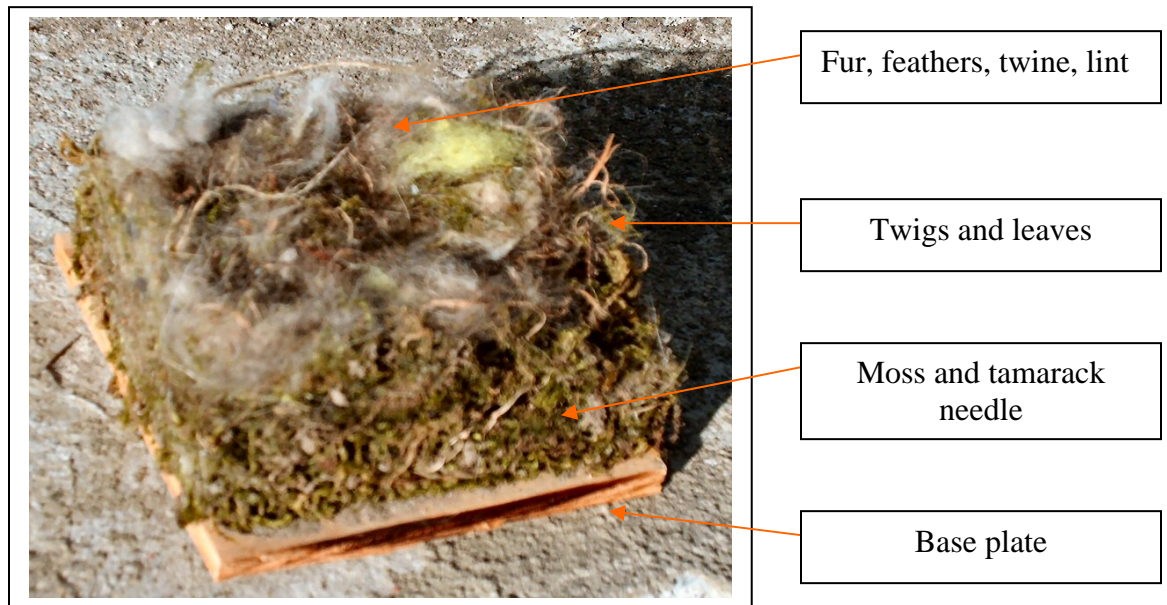

Nest Cleanout After Fledging

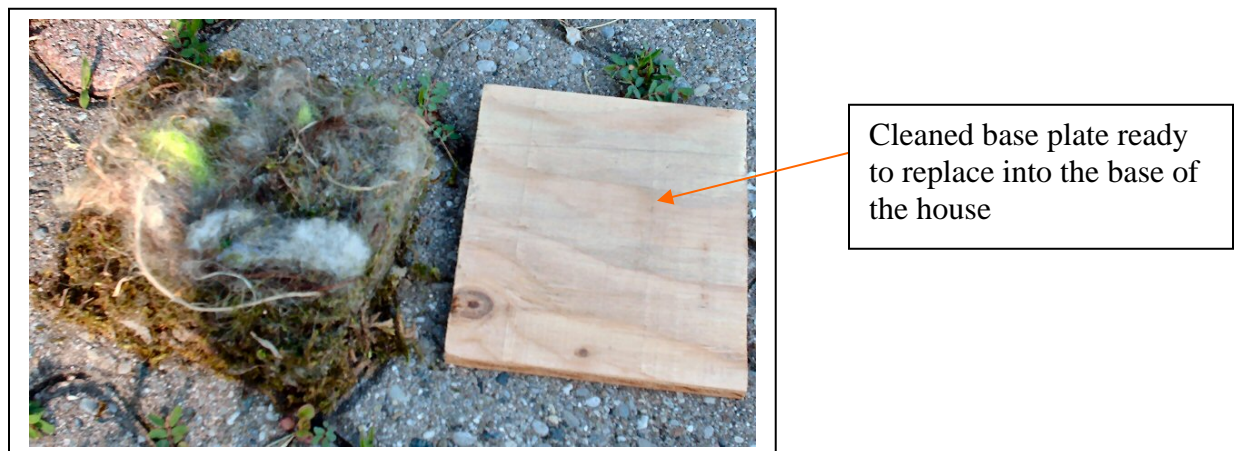
Once the babies have fledged (acquired the feathers enough to fly) and left the nest you can immediately clean it out for the possibility of another hatch in the same house.

Recommendation: Wear appropriate rubber gloves and mask, clean out should be done outside on a calm day. Place all debris into a plastic bag and seal it for disposal.

Simply slide open the three plastic tabs on the base of the house and remove the base plate.



Simply slide the nest off of the base plate clean the inside, outside and base plate using a diluted solution of hydrogen peroxide either sprayed on or brushed on with a paint brush (scrubbing is not necessary). Replace it back into the base of the house and slide the plastic tabs into locking position.
